Properly Dispose of Unused Medicines



Mix the Medicine With an Undesirable Substance

Remove the medicine from its original container and mix it with coffee grounds or kitty litter, then place the mixture in a sealed bag and dispose of it in the garbage.

Call Your Local Pharmacy

Many pharmacies in your area will take unused medications from you to properly dispose of them. Make sure to call before you go!

Use a Drug Deactivation Bag

Contact your local coalition for a Deterra Drug Deactivation bag. They are easy to use and free to you from your coalition!





Do NOT Flush Them

Do not flush medications down the toilet or sink. Until you can properly dispose of them, make sure they are locked up and out of reach.
