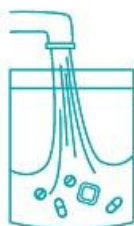
The patented three-step Deterra Drug Deactivation and Disposal System is powered by proprietary organic activated carbon to render drugs inert and safe for disposal in the household trash.

Tear open pouch – do not open or remove inner pod(s). Place unused medications inside.

Fill pouch halfway with warm water and wait 30 seconds for air to release. Some foaming may occur.

Seal pouch tightly, gently shake and dispose of in normal trash.

Note: To deactivate and dispose of transdermal patches, attach the sticky side of the patch to a facial tissue and insert the patch and tissue into the Deterra Pouch.

TIPS FOR SAFE MEDICATION USE

Follow all instructions. Read all the labels on your medication before using it and use your medicine in the manner intended.

Use the right amount. Do not take larger or smaller doses if you feel like you need more or less medication. This can be very dangerous, sometimes even deadly.

Check expiration dates. If a medication has expired, it may be harmful to ingest. Once the expiration date has passed, safely get rid of your medication using the Detera Drug Deactivation and Disposal System.

Be prepared in case of an emergency. Have an emergency plan in case anything goes wrong with your medication, including who to contact and where to go in an emergency.

TIPS FOR SAFE MEDICATION STORAGE

Keep out of reach of children. Storing your medication somewhere where children cannot reach or see them helps prevent dangerous accidents.

Put medicine away every time. Never leaving medication out where others can easily access it can help ensure that only the person to whom it is prescribed uses it.

Communicate about safety. Letting everyone in your household know the safety precautions around medication can help keep them safe from medication misuse or abuse.
